Some Christians agree:

Some agree: lots of suffering in the world> natural disasters, poverty, war, divorce>God should prevent this

BIBLE: He allowed Jesus to die on the cross>did not intervene. The Holocaust went ahead and 6m Jews died

Some Christians disagree:

most suffering is man-made>divorce, adultery, murder, poverty>free will>God allows us to make our own moral decisions. God is more concerned with our character than our comfort>God allows us to suffer to teach us/help us to grow. BIBLE: Book of Job teaches that suffering is part of life & to trust God.

POTENTIAL WEAK ARGUMENT: God allowed Jesus to die (this was part of God's plan to make atonement for human sin).
