Key beliefs about the incarnation

Beliefs that Jesus is the Son of God

When Jesus was baptised, a voice from Heaven said, 'You are my Son'.

Mark 1:11

FULLY MAN

Jesus wept. He felt emotions like all humans. *John 11:35*

Jesus has a job and a mother and brothers and sisters. *Mark 6:3*

Jesus was tired, this shows that he has a human Body. *John 4:6*

Jesus had a normal human birth. *Luke 2:7*

Jesus felt distress and sorrow like every other human. *Mark 14:34*

Jesus died. *Luke 23:46*

The high priest asked him another question, "Are you the Messiah, the Son of the glorious God?" "Yes, I am!" Jesus answered.'

FULLY GOD

The wind and waves obey him. This shows that he is God because he can break the rules of nature.

Mark 4:41

Jesus feeds 5000 with five loaves and two fish. Again, he breaks the laws of nature, showing that he is God. *Mark 6:41-44*

Jesus Heals a man with leprosy – only God could do this. *Matthew 8:3*

Thomas calls Jesus, 'My Lord and my God.' *John 20:28*

Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead. Only God could do this. *John 11:38-44*
