
### **NEED TO KNOW**

**'Saving a life' (Pikuach Nefesh)**: This principle **overrides all other religious laws** because saving a **human life** should be of upmost importance in any situation.


























Today, many Jews believe that organ transplants are a way to save a life. However, others believe that the body should be buried complete and are opposed to the idea.
