# NATURE OF GOD AND CREATOR Judaism Beliefs & Teachings

Monotheistic: Belief in only one God

- Judaism is a monotheistic religion (belief in one God)
- God is the source of all Jewish morality, beliefs and value
- God is the only creator
- God created everything in this world and outside it

- God also created evil

- God not only created the world, but he sustains it, meaning he keeps it going
- God has created everything we need in this world, when humans mismanage their resources that's when people suffer
- Some Jews prefer writing G-d as a sign of respect

Shema: a Jewish prayer affirming belief in one God. Omnipotent: all-powerful. Omniscient: all-knowing. Omnipresent: all-present (everywhere at all times).

## The Shema Prayer

'Hear o Israel! The Lord is our God, the Lord alone. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might'

In the Tanakh it says... 'In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.'

In the Tanakh it says... 'I am the Lord and there is none else, I form light and create darkness, I make weal and create woe – I the Lord do all these things.'

In the Tanakh it says... 'God saw all that he had made, and it was very good.'

Orthodox Jews take the creation story to be 100% accurate as it is the word of God. It does not matter what science says.

Reform Jews however might take the creation story metaphorically, so may combine both science and the creation story

- influences Jews to understand that evil has a purpose in this world and we should trust that God has a reason for this which we may not understand
