 <u>The festival of Pesach demonstrates</u> <u>God's omnipotence</u> and <u>omnibenevolence</u>: The power and inclination shown in rescuing his people from slavery The hardship the Jews have faced in the past but will be saved and redeemed if they remain faithful: can help in recent times of trouble and persecution (<i>influence</i>) Marks the beginning of their journey to the Promised Land which remains a key concept for Jews today Confirms Moses as a key figure in Jewish history and fighting for the faith Leads onto the Covenant at Sinai in which Moses is given the 10 Commandments


